REQUEST REFERENCES | Provide [this link](#) to an executive or principal from each firm and ask them to complete and submit on your firm's behalf.

WAIT FOR REVIEW & APPROVAL | All member applications must be reviewed and approved by the WSIA Membership & Ethics Committee and the WSIA Board of Directors. Upcoming deadlines to submit completed application files are [available here](#) on the WSIA website.

You will be contacted if there are any outstanding questions regarding your application once it has been reviewed, and again as soon as your firm's application has been reviewed/approved.
