Insurance Scholarships

The Derek Hughes/NAPSLO Educational Foundation has established a number of scholarships to support the study of insurance and to reward exceptional students with interest in an insurance career.

Many of the scholarships were established to recognize contributions made by industry leaders, such as Rolland L. Wieggers, Herbert W. Kaufman, Scott W. Polley, Richard E. Hull, Russell Bond, Gary E. Frohn, Michael J. Snead and Kevin A. McLaughlin.

The Foundation annually awards approximately 14 scholarships of \$5,000 each. One scholarship is reserved each year for a student nominated by WSIA.

To be eligible students must

- Be enrolled full-time (12 credit hours per semester) in an undergraduate degree program either:
 - (1) majoring, minoring or pursuing a concentration in Risk Management & Insurance,
 - (2) pursuing coursework in Risk Management & Insurance, or
 - (3) have work experience in the insurance industry.
- Have and maintain a 3.25 overall GPA or 3.5 major GPA.

To apply students must

Complete and submit ALL application elements electronically to WSIA. These include:

- an online application,
- an essay component,
- a resume conforming to the preferred format,
- a reference letter from a non-family member that speaks to your individual character personally and specifically,
- an electronic copy of your unofficial transcript.

Previous recipients of this scholarship are eligible to receive it in subsequent years but must reapply.

Scholarship applications will be available in early-January and are due by April 1. If you have questions, please contact Christine Timmerman, chris@wsia.org.

Scholarship recipients are notified by mail and scholarship funds are awarded to the student's school for distribution.
